To all participants in the 2017 Nutmeg games and Ct State JOAD Championship:

I want to explain the delay in posting scores for the tournament. At the conclusion of every tournament, I personally review and recalculate every score card. The process took much longer than expected this time.

When we review the cards, all the math is checked and we examine the card for changed arrow score that do not have a judge signature. If the math error results in a lower score, the adjustment is made. In the event of a changed arrow score without signature, that arrow scores a zero. In the math error results in a higher score, you are not given the higher score.

Please be aware that there were 38 score cards where there were either math errors or unsigned arrow score changes that resulted in scores being adjusted downward. There were 11 scorecards that had math errors that would have resulted in a higher score and in some cases the errors were large enough that a first place finish could have been the result with proper math.

It is imperative that you check your scores and math before handing in your scorecard. You must remember that any change to an arrow score, MUST BE SIGNED BY A JUDGE!!! When it happens!!
